5- Question Test in Lectora 12 was presented to demo limitations of older Lectora versions:

- Results would appear in unattractive pop-up window, hard to adjust information in window
- Customization was limited
- Old test results did not work with responsive titles
- Could not save test object

Lectora 17 Demo:

- When you select Show test results on RESULTS ribbon, results show on a page that you can format
- Must have one GoToNext if you want to control where the page goes
- Results object is unique, has own properties on ribbon
- Results Designer lets you define styles, options, and images (that are scaled correctly) for your test results, includes General Settings, Correct Questions, Incorrect Questions, and Unanswered Questions tabs
- Responsive titles let you view different result layouts
- Different pass/fail results
- Vertical Scroll Off – Results object and page will grow to fit contents, if On, will feature vertical scroll bars to view questions

- She is currently bundling SCOs in SCORM 1.2 package – how to move functionality for setting a prerequisite for an assignable unit to xAPI?
